Academic Activity



Tula State University carries out a diversified training of specialists of all levels in the fields of engineering, mathematics, natural sciences, medical, socio-economic and humanitarian areas. The University offers 48 Bachelor programs, 43 Master programs, 11 Engineer qualification programs, as well as programs in 28 research areas for postgraduates.

University graduates are demanded by large Russian and international companies in different industries of the domestic and global economy.

Science



The University has 12 Doctoral Dissertation Councils. About 3-5 doctoral and around 40 dissertations of candidate of science are submitted annually.

Scientific studies are conducted in more than 69 scientific fields.

The number of faculty at the University makes 1,100 people, including 207 doctors and 645 candidates of science, 136 honorary members of higher education, masters of science, inventors.

The educational activity attracts 250 highly qualified representatives of economic and social sectors, the main collaborators of scientific and educational organizations of Russia.

International Cooperation



Tula State University started training international students in 1962, with the first highly qualified graduates being from Bulgaria.

International students have a great interest in Tula State University due to a wide choice of academic programs, variety of education modes, and reasonable combination of education quality and tuition fees.

Besides, the important factor is the geographical location of Tula and its proximity to Moscow and other historical and cultural spots of the country.

International Cooperation



The University provides the international students with:

- Pre-University Course of Russian;
- Bachelor, Master and Specialist Programs;
- Internship in Medicine;
- Post-Graduate Courses and Doctoral School;
- •Summer Programs of Russian.

Most international students choose "General Medicine" program that is delivered by inpractice doctors at the modern bases for clinical practice.

International Cooperation



The language of training at Tula State University is Russian. International applicants who do not speak Russian are encouraged to undergo a 10-month course for pre-university Russian language training.

There are 5 main fields for pre-university Russian language training: Engineering and Technical Sciences, Economics, Humanities, Natural Sciences and Biomedical Sciences. The tuition fee for a 10-month pre-university training course is € 1,400

These programs are aimed at reaching B1 Russian proficiency level that allows the international students to do studies at Tula State University or other universities of Russia.

The University offers academic exchange programs (in the form of an international semester) for our partner universities on equal terms.

Summer Programs




We provide Summer Russian Language Programs with the total duration of 80 hours (20 h per week).

The fees:

- •14,000 rubles / 200 € for groups of 4 people.
- •20,000 rubles / 200 € for groups of 2 people.
- •30,000 rubles / 415 € for individual studies.

Students taking these programs live in the University hostels in center of Tula. These intense programs of learning the Russian language include practical lessons, trainings and cultural excursions around Tula.
